1. Catalyzer Award

- **Purpose:** Provides research support for collecting preliminary data to support a future grant submission and/or supplemental support for ongoing sponsored research for work outside the aims and/or scope of work of the funded project.
- **Project Period:** 1 year
- **Maximum Funding:** \$25 000 USD

- **Purpose:** Supports exploratory and cutting-edge research by providing support for early and conceptual stages of project development geared towards addressing healthcare needs worldwide.
- **Project Period:** 2 years
- **Maximum Funding:** \$250 000 USD
